There was one notable transaction, we did receive our refund from INKT for 641.75. The only way to account for this is to count it as income.

Instead of boring everyone with all the various deposits and debts, I wanted to focus on where we are as a whole. Currently we have a little over \$15,000 in available funds. We are budgeted to spend a little over \$25,000 through the rest of the year. Our last big fundraiser, the Cardnival, should net us \$10,000 to cover all expenses. I don't believe we will run into a funding problem at this time, but there is the potential for one. We will also have other, smaller sources of income through the year to help. We do need these sources to raise at least \$4,000 to cover the amount of cushion needed in or bank account. I also believe this to be probable at this time.
